Passport/VISA info: Canadians travelling to Italy will require a minimum of 6 months validity on their passport.

Currency: Euro is the preferred method of payment. Most places will accept credit/debit cards. ATMs are commonly found throughout the country.

Official Languages: Italian

Water: It is safe to drink the tap water anywhere in Italy

Electric Current: 230V at 50 Hz. A Type C travel adapter is required to use Canadian plugs in Italian outlets.

Time Zone: Traveling in April/May, Italy will be observing daylight savings. At this time, Italy will be in Central European Summer Time (UTC+2).

Seasons:

Spring: Temperatures approximately 5-25°C from March - May Summer: Temperatures approximately 26-34°C from June - August

Population: Italy - 59 million people

Hospitality: The Hospitality desk will be open daily from 9 a.m. until 4 p.m., outside of group excursion times. The Lorandus Meetings' support team will be at the Hospitality Desk daily to answer any questions you may have about your trip or to assist you with your leisure time.

Driver's Licence Requirements: Canadian travellers must carry a valid provincial driver's licence while driving in Italy. An International Driving Permit (IDP) is strongly recommended and may be required by rental agencies. In place of an IDP, an official sworn translation of your Canadian licence into Italian is also accepted.
